



MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT PROPOSAL – WEST RIVER

TAKE NOTICE that the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission (the “Commission”) has received a proposal to create the Rural Municipality of West River (the “Proposal”) pursuant to section 15 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSPEI 1988, c M-12.1 (the “Act”).

BACKGROUND

The applicants propose to create the Rural Municipality of West River. The proposed municipality includes the incorporated municipalities of **New Haven-Riverdale, Bonshaw, West River, Afton, and Meadowbank**.

The proposed municipality may affect, but does not include, the Rural Municipality of Clyde River and the Town of Cornwall. The applicants do not propose to annex any unincorporated parcels or areas.

The proposal states that the estimated population of the area of the proposed municipality is approximately 3,154 individuals.
