GREETING

A P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS Section 1D of The Community Improvement Act
1968 (17 Eliz. II, Cap. 11) enacts as follows:

- "1D (1) The Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council may,
where the residents of a proposed community
have recommended the establishment of a
committee and have recommended the
geographical boundaries of the community,
establish a committee and fix the
geographical boundaries of the community.
- (2) The Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council shall
establish a committee and fix the
geographical boundaries of a community by
proclamation.
- (3) The Minister may appoint not less than six
persons recommended by the residents at
the meeting held pursuant to Section 1B to
act as members until the first annual
meeting held by the committee, and such
persons shall hold office until the first
annual meeting is held by the committee."

AND WHEREAS the residents of the former school districts
of St. Catherines, New Argyle, Canoe Cove and Long Creek have
recommended the establishment of a West River Community
Improvement Committee and have recommended geographical bound-
aries of the community;

AND BEING SATISFIED that all of the provisions of The
Community Improvement Act 1968 have been complied with;

NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice and consent
of Our Executive Council for Prince Edward Island do by this
Our Proclamation establish a community improvement committee
to be known as the "West River Community Improvement Committee"
and fix the geographical boundaries of the said community as
those of the former School Districts of St. Catherines, New
Argyle, Canoe Cove and Long Creek.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters
to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Prince Edward Island
to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS the Honourable John George MacKay, Lieutenant-
Governor of the Province of Prince Edward Island, at
Charlottetown this twenty-third day of May in the year of
Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and in the
twenty-third year of Our Reign.

MEMORANDUM TO EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

SUBJECT: COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT REQUEST TO DESIGNATE ST.
CATHERINES, NEW ARGYLE, CANOE COVE & LONG CREEK AREAS.

SUBMITTED BY: DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES

SUMMARY:

The Executive Council is requested to consider a proposal to establish a Community Improvement Committee for the areas for the old school districts of St. Catherines, New Argyle, Canoe Cove & Long Creek.

1. BACKGROUND:

- 1.1 The Community Improvement Act (L.P.E.I. 1968 Cap. II) prescribes the procedure to establish a Committee and to define the geographical boundaries of the Community.
- 1.2 The Act provides that the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council may establish the Committee and fix the geographical boundaries by proclamation.
- 1.3 The Minister may appoint not less than 6 persons, recommended by the residents at a public meeting, to act as Committee members to hold office until the first annual meeting is held by the Committee.

2. FACTORS:

- 2.1 A public meeting held May 15, 1974 pursuant to the provisions of the Act has recommended that the establishment of a Committee for the community consisting of the old school districts of St. Catherines, New Argyle, Canoe Cove and Long Creek.
- 2.2 The meeting recommended that the Committee members be Mr. Winston Mason, Mr. Dale MacKenzie, Mr. Vincent MacKenzie, Mr. Floyd Stretch, Mr. Ralph MacKinnon, Mr. Arnold MacEachern, Mr. Joseph MacKenzie and Mr. Charles MacMillan.
- 2.3 The meeting also recommended that the above Committee be named the West River Community Improvement Committee.

3. RECOMMENDATION:

That the Executive Council establish a Community Improvement Committee of West River having the geographical boundaries as follows: all that area of land contained within the old school districts of St. Catherines, New Argyle, Canoe Cove, and Long Creek.
